NOTICE INVITING APPLICATIONS FROM NGOs/CBOs FOR EMPANELMENT FOR PROJECT IN HIV/AIDS TARGETED INTERVENTIONS UNDER ASACS.

Applications are invited from interested civil Society organisations in the districts of Kamrup, Karimganj, Tinsukia, Udalguri, Barpeta, Dhubri, Lakhimpur, Dhemaji, Biswanath and Hailakandi, of Assam for empanelling themselves to implement HIV/AIDS targeted interventions with highly vulnerable population groups like Female Sex Workers (FSW), Injecting Drug Users (IDU), Man having Sex with Man (MSM), Migrant Labour (ML) and Truckers community.

The project which is an intervention with a goal of reducing the burden of HIV/AIDS cases. The components of the projects are prevention, care and support, Linkages and treatment, programme management and strategic information management with one of each sub-components being targeted intervention for high risk groups, as well as utilizing Civil Society Organizations for providing access of vulnerable populations to various HIV/AIDS interventions.

CBOs/NGOs that are registered societies, trusts and active in community work are eligible to apply.
