Call for Expression of Interest (EOI) from Reputed Companies/ Firms / Organizations for Bio Medical Waste Management under Assam State AIDS Control Society

Assam State AIDS Control Society (ASACS) is a registered society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 for implementation of the National AIDS Control Programme (NACP) in the state of Assam. Assam State AIDS Control Society has a Central Storage facility located in Nizom Path, Sixmile, Guwahati-22. The Central Store of ASACS Plays a vital role in uninterrupted distribution of various health care items like Test Kits, Blood Bags, Condoms, Medicines etc. to the facility centers.

Various bio-medical wastes in the form of test kits, blood bags, condoms, needle-syringes, vacuumed blood collection tubes, medicines etc. are generated and have accumulated at the place of ASACS Store/ Warehouse. Since the store/ warehouse is functioning in a rented house, it is not possible to establish an in-house Bio-Medical Waste disposal system in ASACS store. Therefore, it is decided to engage an external Bio-Medical Waste Management firm for disposing the bio medical waste generated/ accumulated in ASACS Store.

Expression of Interest invited from licensed companies/firms for collection and disposing the bio medical waste generated/ accumulated in ASACS store.

Eligibility:

The eligibility will be assessed against evidence of skills and experience in collection and disposal of Bio-Medical Waste. The company/firm must have valid license for bio-medical waste management from the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committee (PCC). The company/firms must have their own facilities (WHO-GMP/GMP certified) in India. The company must have 3 (three) years experience in collection and disposing of Bio-Medical Waste.

Assessment:

The assessment of firm will be made on the basis of price offered for collection and disposing Bio-Medical Waste per Kilogram basis. The firm will have to sign a MoU with ASACS initially for a period of 1 (one) year, which may be extended up to a period of 3 (three) years, on the basis of performance of the company/firm with consent of both the parties. However, the EOI inviting authority may cancel/ terminate the agreement without assigning any reason thereof with 1 (one) month notice.

Requirements:

The EOI should be sent along with a Capability Statement including a profile of the organization, and necessary certificate. Any EOI with inadequate information, those which do not meet the above criteria, or those received after the closing date will not be short listed. EOI should be as concise and focused as possible to give evidence of the above requirements including the capability statement and organization profiles. The EOI must reach the undersigned on or before **3PM 12th September, 2022**. Only organizations, which pass the pre-selection process, will be contacted and invited to submit detailed proposals.
